

: There are 12 question types in Kodiak. Some questions are appropriate for quizzes and tests (i.e., True/False or Multiple Choice), but others are more suited to surveys since they cannot be automatically graded (i.e., Likert Question).

9. Populate the question and answer sections with text as appropriate.
10. Click .
11. Repeat steps 7-9 until all questions have been added to the section in the Question Library.
12. Click on the top-right side of the page.

You can create a quiz that randomly draws questions from your Question Library once you have set it up. You can set up your quiz so that it draws questions from one section or from multiple sections of your Question Library.

1. Go to your area.
2. Click
3. Enter a name for the quiz.
4. Click (Figure 3).
5. Click , and select from the drop-down menu (Figure 4).
8. Click . You will now be taken to an index page for the quiz.
8. Click on the name of the section you just created in the index list on the left.
9. Click at the top-left of the page.
10. Select the appropriate section from your Question Library on the down menu (Figure 5). A list of all questions saved to this section will appear.
